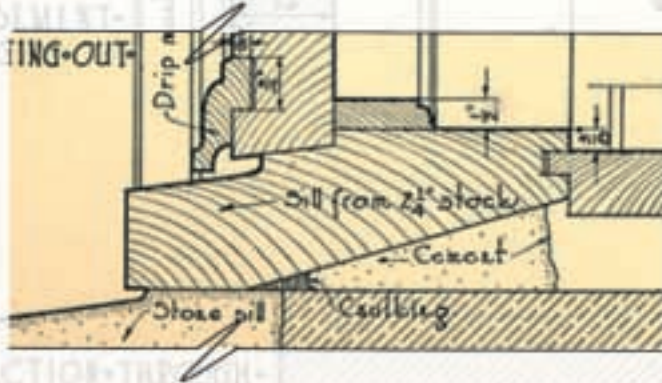

A double stepped sill is an important detail in making sure the water stays out. We tested our sills to meet the ASTM 100mph wind and water test and the double step of sill is crucial to satisfactory performance. With out the steps the water was able to hill on the sill and actually spray into the room. After the double step this stopped. Note too that the sills should slope at least 5 degrees 10 if the design allows. This too keeps out the water and is a better performing detail.

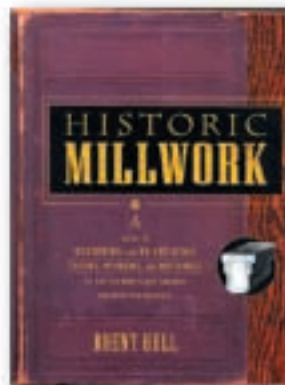
